#### **EUROPE'S GATEWAY TO SPACE**

**WHAT** 

22 Member States, 5000 employees

WHY

Exploration and use of space for exclusively peaceful purposes

WHERE

HQ in Paris, 7 sites across Europe and a spaceport in French Guiana

**HOW MUCH** 

€6.49 billion (2021) = €12 per European per year



## ESA's Blue Worlds Task Force (BWTF)



- Part of ESA's Regional approach;
- Building on an ESA mapping exercise (2019);
- Gathers representatives from ESA Member States & Associated together with ESA experts;
- Discusses the scope of nexus between the needs and expectations of maritime world w.r.t. space assets, technologies and data;
- Survey was suggested by BWTF Member States



## **ESA Regional Approach**





### **BWTF Survey**



Target and Objective: collecting views of maritime users with the view of enhancing the collaboration;

Disseminated to maritime users, operators, players, national authorities and research centres;

- 28 questions (multiple choice / open) :
  - Details about the respondee (anonymised)
  - Maritime priorities & their drivers
  - Knowledge of and perceived potential of Space assets
  - Deadline extended 7 March 2021 Interest and modalities of a possible follow up
  - Open comments
